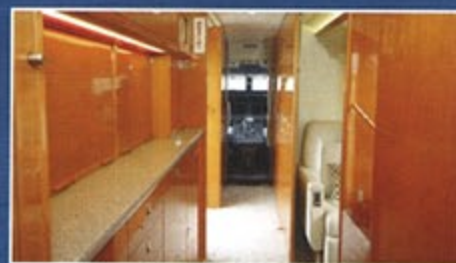


# All about you



FAI rent-a-jet believes that you wait around enough in life, without having to wait for a flight. That's why they believe you should fit your flights around your timetable, and not the other way around.



Flying can be tiresome enough for executive passengers. There's the searching for a parking space at the airport, waiting in line to check-in, delays, cancellations and having to interchange flights just to get to your destination. At FAI they believe that scheduled flights should not rule your timetable. They believe it is the customer's timetable that needs to be planned around, offering maximum flexibility when setting up important meetings and appointments.

FAI rent-a-jet firmly believes you should drive up to the aircraft, board and depart, and this is the exact service they aim to offer to their customers.

The company's goal is to provide long-standing and productive relationships with its clients customized to meet specific requirements. Clients can get quotations directly from the

owner and operator of each aircraft, thus avoiding the payment of intermediaries and within half an hour, allowing them to work out their finances without delay.

The plan of action is then defined according to the needs of the passenger and the wishes of the client at that time. FAI is known for their affordable pricing with maximum service. Founded in 1986, FAI (Flight Ambulance International) rent-a-jet was originally a 100 percent subsidiary of a private club under the company name of IFA-Flugbetriebs GmbH. In 1989 the private club sold the company by an outsourcing process and the company's name was changed into FAI. Since that time, the company has been owned by the Axtmann Family's Holding and is a fully independent company.

In 1991 FAI took over the GRUNDIG Flight Department during another outsourcing process and for many years FAI was busy in different sectors of the General Aviation Market, such as Air Ambulance, Executive Charter, Maintenance and Aircraft Leasing.

Since 2001 when FAI acquired its first two Learjet Aircraft (Learjet 35A + Learjet 55), the company has been concentrating in the air ambulance business, but still also pays great attention to its executive clients, which include certain Formula One teams.

In 2008 the Axtmann-Family sold a 49,9 percent stake in FAI to MIG Aviation Holdings Ltd., Nicosia, Cyprus, a 100 % subsidiary of MIG Marfin Investment Group Holdings S. A., Athens, Greece, which is not only the largest Investment

Group in Greece, but also one of the largest ones in Eastern Europe.

Since 2009, when a factory new Falcon 900 DX EASy joined the fleet, FAI has expanded the activities in Executive Travel by adding in 2010 one Global Express, one CRJ 200 and one CL 604 to the fleet. This year the acquisition of a second Global Express and a second Challenger are planned

In 2010 FAI announced record sales and is currently employing 160 employees at its home base in Nuremberg, Germany. Besides this main base FAI maintains line stations in Dakar in Senegal, Abidjan in Ivory Coast, Entebbe in Uganda and El Fasher in Sudan. Towards the end of this year the company plan to open another line station in Dubai, demonstrating the ever-growing market all around the globe. ■
